Patient Instructions After Crown or Bridge Treatment

We perform crown and/or bridge procedure. For your comfort and safety, remember that you have a temporary crown after your first visit. This protects and serves as a placeholder while your custom crown is being prepared. Should your temporary crown become loose or fall off, call us immediately.

A temporary crown is not intended for a long-term use, so it is vital for you to have your temporary crown replaced with a permanent crown. While wearing the temporary crown you may experience discomfort in treatment areas. Also, your teeth may become sensitive to cold or pressure. Try using a toothpaste for sensitive teeth.

Once your temporary crown or bridge is removed and a permanent one placed, please allow a few days to adjust to your new crown or bridge. Slight discomfort or sensitivity is normal. If after several days, you experience discomfort, please call us immediately.

To maintain your crown or bridge, continue with regular brushing and flossing. Remember, it is very important to keep the area along the gum line clean.
